First is information about the Halloween and the Holiday Decorations Contests.

Next is a reminder about the property tax rebate. The dead-

line for applications is December 17th, and we don't want anyone to miss out.

Finally, if you have kids, please note the trick or treat hours are 4:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. And be sure to bring the kids to the Halloween event at the Police Department on October 14th! It's bigger every year and is always a fun event as well as an opportunity for children to have a positive experience with our officers.

Property Tax Rebates

Property tax rebate applications were mailed out on September 4, 2018! Applications can also be printed directly from our website at:

ci.montgomery.il.us. This rebate is made possible by the referendum passed in November 2014 implementing a 1% non-home rule sales tax.

Property tax rebate checks in the amount of \$45 will be mailed to the owner(s) of each residential property who submit a qualifying application. Applications must be postmarked by December 17, 2018 to the Village of Montgomery, 200 N. River St., Montgomery, IL 60538. Property tax rebate checks for approved applications will be mailed out by April 30, 2019.

Electrical Aggregation

Each year the Village of Montgomery seeks competitive bids for electrical power on behalf of its residents. Since the beginning of this program in 2012, it has saved nearly \$250 per household for a cumulative \$1.15 million in savings Village-wide.

This summer the bids received were all higher than the ComEd rate of 7.75¢ per kilowatt hour. Therefore, those who participate in the Village's electrical aggregation program will be automatically switched to ComEd effective with their meter read date in October 2018. Next summer the Village will seek bids again and will provide another update at that time.

Recycling Event Changes

The final quarterly recycling event of 2018 (for Village of Montgomery residents only—ID required) will be Saturday, October 20th, from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Public Works facility at 891 Knell Road off of Route 31.

TVs of all types, all electronics (basically anything with an electric plug or batteries), metal, batteries, and household hazardous waste will be accepted for recycling with no charge. In 2019 the quarterly events will take place on the 3rd Saturday of January, April, July and October.

VILLAGE OF MONTGOMERY OCTOBER 2018

Leaf Pickup

During October and November, Village public works crews provide bulk leaf pick-up services to Village residents. Leaves must be raked neatly no more than 5' from the curb/edge of roadway in front of the home by 7 a.m. on Monday of each collection week.

Crews will make one pass through the Village during the following weeks: October 29th, November 5th, and November 12th. Additional pickups will continue as needed until the end of November. Grass clippings, sticks, twigs and other debris cannot be collected by the leaf vac. Placement of foreign debris in the leaf piles will result in the crew skipping your address. Additionally, crews cannot vacuum leaves that are within 10' of a tree, mailbox, fire hydrant, street light, street sign, etc. Do not park cars in front of the leaves to be collected, as our leaf vac will not be able to reach them.

Leaves for bulk pick-up must be placed on the parkway in front of the property from which they originate, so please do not rake leaves into the street or onto other lots.

The Village's refuse hauler, LRS/DC Trash, will also pick up leaves each week on your regularly scheduled collection day for no additional charge. There are no stickers needed, however, you will need to put the leaves in yard waste bags or clearly marked 32-gallon yard waste cans with two handles. Bags must be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before your scheduled collection.

Please remember—leaf burning is prohibited by Village ordinance.

Holiday Decorations Contest




The Beautification Committee will also offer a Holiday Decorations Contest this year in December to recognize homes and businesses for exceptional holiday displays.
