Mayor's Message - Matt Brolley

Last year, the Village received a grant to fund a pedestrian bridge over Route 30 near Stuart Sports Complex. The funding is crucial as we begin engineering the overpass planned for 2026. Additionally, we continue to work towards the essential transition from our current sandstone aquifer water source to Lake Michigan, continuing to collaborate with Oswego, Yorkville, and the DuPage Water Commission as we plan this long-term project. This year, we will continue to invest in water infrastructure, the Lake Michigan allocation, and watermain replacement, preparing us for this crucial transition.

Already in 2024, our Board and Staff are reviewing the budget for Fiscal Year '25, and we are working on a five-year strategic plan. The renovation of Montgomery Park is underway, and we look forward to a ribbon cutting in the summer and showcasing the new amenities at Montgomery Fest 2024 (August 16-18).

I would be remiss if I didn't mention the most talked about project of this year, the addition of Cooper's Hawk Restaurant and Starbucks at Ogden Hill (Ogden Ave. and Rt. 30). We know that there is a need for enhanced retail and dining in our community. We look forward to these exciting new developments for our community.

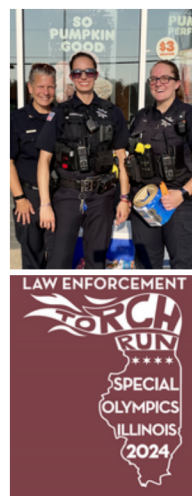
